Overview:

- ◆ The Konza Environmental Education Program's objective is to teach students the process of science through hands-on ecological research during their visit to the tallgrass prairie.
- ◆ Our program invites K-12 teachers to our site for one week in the summer to learn all of the different activities available to students.
- ◆ Teachers immerse themselves into the prairie! The group works together to learn about the prairie and conduct each of the activities available.
- ◆ During the week, teachers construct an individualized experience tailored for their class.
- ◆ We then help plan a visit for the class to visit the prairie and participate in the program developed by the teacher!



Perks for participants:

- ◆ Teachers who participate in a Summer Workshop qualify for a \$125 bus credit to bring their students to the prairie.
